## LIGHTING DESIGN IN THE WINTER TOWNSCAPE

Professional Lighting Designers' Association (PLDA), Notodden Municipality, Telemark, Buskerud and Vestfold county councils, national and local partners in lighting and spatial planning invite you to an international lighting conference in Telemark, Norway on the occasion of the PLDA's practical lighting workshop in Notodden 2009. Venue: Telemarksgalleriet in Notodden.

Winter light in Telemark is an event with a local, regional and international perspective addressing the crossover between lighting design and creative urban planning. Lighting design can be an important tool to support urban life in a rugged winter climate.
